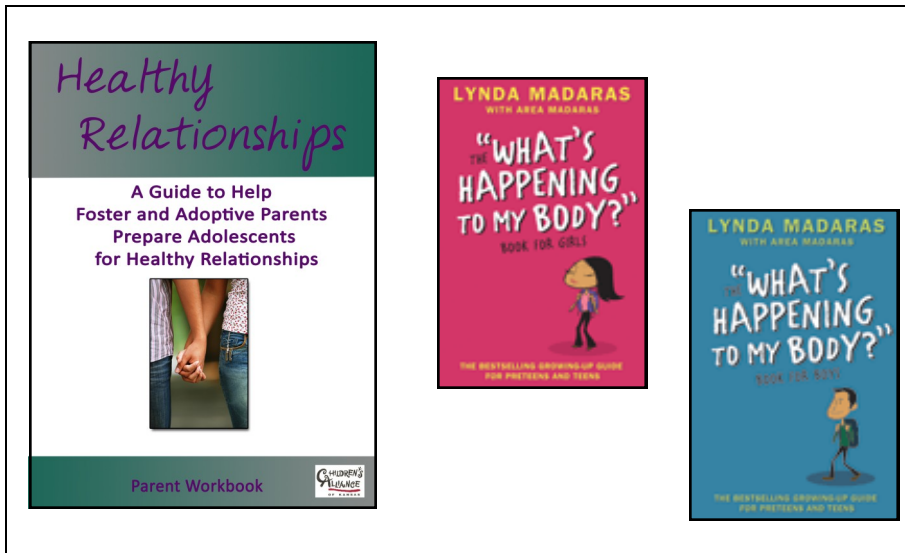

The Kansas Foster and Adoptive Parent Association is pleased to announce a partnership with the Children's Alliance of Kansas in the development of a training for families about healthy relationships. This curriculum is part of the Children's Alliance Healthy Life Choices Project, a five year grant. The ultimate goals of this project are to delay sexual activity of children ages 10-15 and reduce teen pregnancy.

Every foster/adoptive parent will be eligible for this training. Every home that completes the course will receive a free membership to KFAPA. The What's Happening To My Body books will be given to foster parents who start the course who have children ages 10-15. The expected release date of the training is October 2011.

In addition to free KFAPA membership, the children working through the course with their parents will be eligible, upon completion of the course, to win prizes. These prizes will range from Wal-Mart gift cards to i-pods, etc.
